Call for Papers

Ornamental Horticulture is seeking submissions for a special edition titled "Turfgrass". This issue seeks contributions that explore the most diverse areas of ornamental turfgrass, sports turfgrass and sod production. Specifically, it searches for manuscripts that visualize advances, new techniques and technologies, processes and applications in the turfgrass sector.

It is important to consider the current demands of the segment, as turfgrass have taken a prominent position worldwide both for their admirable aesthetic value and for their much functionality. In sports fields there has been a radical change in the concept of quality where new deployment and maintenance technologies are required by organizing committees such as CBF, CONMEBOL, FIFA and USGA, which creates new challenges in maintaining sports varieties, especially in low light conditions.

The sod production fields gained new cultivars that were marketed in various parts of the world, which led to an expansion of new production areas. In addition, the landscaping sector has gained momentum with the high demand for turfgrass for use in residential, private, public gardens, parks, plazas and cemeteries, and highway margins have become a true field of quality turfgrass. Faced with the constant expansion of the sector, several demands for technical and scientific information are generated each year.

Thus, Ornamental Horticulture journal seeks high quality original scientific, technical or proofreading work. This special edition aims to provide a podium for the work of national and international experts to summarize recent achievements in these fields. Potential topics related to this special edition may include, but are not limited to, the ornamental turfgrass, sports turfgrass and sod production.
